# **Listed Questions and Answers**

# Where is the list of benefits for each sponsor level?

To reflect our vision of creating an inclusive society where all can thrive, GEO is intentionally moving away from a sponsorship model that includes extrinsic benefits and instead focusing on the benefits your sponsorship has for our community.

This means that all sponsors will be recognized similarly with written recognition in print and online materials, including but not limited to the GEO conference webpage, on-site signage, printed program book and at key sessions throughout the event. # Why the change?

We want to focus on the impact of our supporters.

Tiered sponsorship benefit models detract from the gift of support that organizations like yours make to our community. We believe that support of GEO's conference is not a transaction but rather a step toward meaningful change in the nonprofit and philanthropic sector.

### What is community-driven fundraising exactly and how does it relate to this change?

GEO defines "community-driven philanthropy" as an emphasis on participation, engagement and shared power in the fundraising space.

As part of our goal to create shared power in the community, we believe that it's important to eliminate any illusions of positional power based on giving amount. This means that GEO is no longer tiering its sponsor lists based on giving amount so that we better recognize that support goes far beyond monetary contribution. All conference supporters will be recognized equitably for their gifts of time, thought, and financial resources.

# How many complimentary tickets will I receive as a supporter?

Each supporter who makes a commitment of at least \$5,000 will receive a promotional code good for one complimentary registration as a small token of our gratitude for their support. The fair market value of the complimentary registration is equal to the regular non-member registration rate.

All supporters will also receive access to our membership pricing and earlybird registration period regardless of their current membership status.

# Do I receive a complimentary ticket as a member of the Host Committee?

No, Host Committee members do not receive a complimentary ticket. However, the vast majority of Host Committee organizations are also conference supporters, which means your organization will likely receive a promotional code good for one complimentary registration as a small token of our gratitude.
